A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO DELAY THE SUNSET OF THE EXEMPTION OF CLEANUPS OF PETROLEUM FROM LEAKING UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANKS FROM CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS RELATED TO LAND-USE RESTRICTIONS AND DEED RECORDATION AND TO INCREASE THE ANNUAL OPERATING FEES APPLICABLE TO COMMERCIAL PETROLEUM UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANKS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 4 of S.L. 2000-51 reads as rewritten:

"Section 4. Sections 1 and 2 of this act are effective retroactively to 1 October 1999. Sections 3 and 4 of this act are effective when this act becomes law. Section 1 of this act expires 1 September 2001.2002."

SECTION 2. G.S. 143-215.94C(a) reads as rewritten:

- "(a) For purposes of this subsection, each compartment of a commercial underground storage tank that is designed to independently contain a petroleum product is a separate petroleum commercial underground storage tank. The owner or operator of a commercial petroleum underground storage tank shall pay to the Secretary for deposit into the Commercial Fund an annual operating fee according to the following schedule:
 - (1) For each petroleum commercial underground storage tank of 3,500 gallons or less capacity two hundred dollars (\$200.00).two hundred fifteen dollars (\$215.00).
 - (2) For each petroleum commercial underground storage tank of more than 3,500 gallon capacity three hundred dollars (\$300.00).three hundred fifteen dollars (\$315.00)."

SECTION 3. Section 1 of this act becomes effective 31 August 2000. Section 2 of this act becomes effective 1 January 2002. Section 3 of this act is effective when this act becomes law.
