June 13, 2002 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO GRANT ADDITIONAL FLEXIBILITY WITH REGARD TO THE PURCHASE OF TEXTBOOKS TO THE CHARLOTTE-MECKLENBURG SCHOOLS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding the provisions of Part 3 of Article 8 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes or any other provision of law, the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Local School Administrative Unit may purchase textbooks on the State-adopted list without using the State textbook distribution system or the textbook warehouse facility operated by the State Board of Education. **SECTION 2.** This act applies only to the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Local

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2002.
