1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO REQUIRE JUVENILES TO SUBMIT REQUESTS FOR REVIEW OF
3	EXTENDED COMMITMENT DECISIONS WITHIN TEN DAYS OF RECEIPT
4	OF THE NOTIFICATION OF EXTENDED COMMITMENT.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 7B-2515(c) reads as rewritten:
7	"(c) The juvenile and the juvenile's parent, guardian, or custodian may request a
8	review by the court of the Department's decision to extend the juvenile's commitment
9	beyond the juvenile's eighteenth birthday or maximum commitment period, in which
10	case the court shall conduct a review hearing. period within 10 days of receipt of the
11	written notification that the Department plans to extend the juvenile's commitment. The
12	court shall conduct a review hearing upon receipt of a request for review authorized by
13	this subsection. The court may modify the Department's decision and the juvenile's
14	maximum commitment period. If the juvenile or the juvenile's parent, guardian, or
15	custodian does not request a review of the Department's decision, the Department's
16	decision shall become the juvenile's new maximum commitment period."
17	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2001, and applies to
18	decisions of the Department to extend commitment noticed on or after that date.
