2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR SELECTION OF PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS BY
3	THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IF THE ELECTION RESULTS HAVE NOT BEEN
4	CERTIFIED BY THE SIXTH DAY BEFORE ELECTORS ARE TO MEET, AND
5	BY THE GOVERNOR IF ELECTORS HAVE NOT BEEN SELECTED BY THE
6	DATE ELECTORS ARE TO MEET.
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	<b>SECTION 1.</b> Article 18 of Chapter 163 of the General Statutes is amended
9	by adding a new section to read:
10	" <u>§ 163-213. Appointment of Presidential Electors by General Assembly in certain</u>
11	circumstances, by the Governor in certain other circumstances.
12	(a) Appointment by General Assembly if No Certification by Six Days Before
13	Electors' Meeting Day As permitted by 3 U.S.C. § 2, whenever the election of
14	Presidential Electors has not been certified by the Secretary of State under G.S. 163-210
15	before noon on the date for settling controversies specified by 3 U.S.C. § 5, and upon
16	the call of an extra session pursuant to the North Carolina Constitution for the purposes
17	of this section, the General Assembly may appoint Presidential Electors.
18	(b) Appointment by Governor if No Appointment by Electors' Meeting Day. – If
19	Presidential Electors have not been appointed by noon on the day set for the meeting of
20	Presidential Electors by 3 U.S.C. § 7, then the Governor shall appoint them.
21	(c) <u>Certification by Secretary of State Before Electors' Meeting Day Controls.</u> –
22	If the certification of Presidential Electors under G.S. 163-210 is made any time before
23	noon on the day set for the meeting of Presidential Electors by 3 U.S.C. § 7, then that
24	certification shall control."
25	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
