SECTION 1. G.S. 160A-301 of the General Statutes is amer	nded by adding a
new subsection to read:	
"(b1) A city may by ordinance require that pretowing notices be d	isplayed on lots,
garages, or other parking facilities not owned or leased by the city. Programme of the city of the cit	retowing notices
shall be displayed before vehicles parked without the permission of the	owner or lessee
of the lot, garage, or other parking facility not owned or leased by t	the city, may be
towed or removed from that lot, garage, or other parking facility. The	city may set the
size and nature of the required notices. The city may provide penalties	s for violation of
the ordinance created under this subsection."	
SECTION 2. This act applies to the City of Greenville only.	
SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
