2	AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF A FIREARM ACROSS THE
3	RIGHT-OF-WAY OF A PUBLIC ROAD IN CALDWELL COUNTY FOR THE
4	PURPOSE OF TARGET PRACTICE.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. It is unlawful to discharge a firearm across the right-of-way of
7	any public road for the purpose of target practice.
8	SECTION 2. Violation of this act is a Class 3 misdemeanor.
9	SECTION 3. This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the
10	Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by other peace
11	officers with general subject matter jurisdiction.
12	SECTION 4. This act applies only to Caldwell County.
13	SECTION 5. This act becomes effective October 1, 2001.
