2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE ORANGE COUNTY TO REGULATE THE USE OF
3 ALCOHOL AND OTHER IMPAIRING SUBSTANCES WHILE HUNTING
4 WITH FIREARMS AND TO REGULATE HUNTING NEAR GOVERNMENT
5 BUILDINGS.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** A county may regulate, control, restrict, and prohibit hunting
8 with firearms by persons under the influence of alcohol or other impairing substances
9 and regulate, control, restrict, and prohibit hunting with firearms by persons who have
10 any blood alcohol concentration as measured by an alcosensor. For the purposes of this
11 act, an impairing substance is defined as set forth in G.S. 20-4.01.

12 **SECTION 2.** A county may regulate, control, restrict, and prohibit hunting
13 within 150 yards of any federal, State, or local government building, including those
14 owned or leased by boards of education.

15 **SECTION 3.** A person violating an ordinance enacted under the authority of
16 Sections 1 and 2 of this act is guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor, and upon conviction
17 shall be punished as provided in G.S. 14-4, "Violation of local ordinance misdemeanor."

18 **SECTION 4.** This act applies only to Orange County.

19 **SECTION 5.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
