A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO REDUCE THE CO-PAYMENT AMOUNT 2 3 FOR PRESCRIPTION DRUGS UNDER THE MEDICAID PROGRAM. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: There is appropriated from the General Fund to the 5 SECTION 1. Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Medical Assistance, the sum of 6 three million five hundred thousand dollars (\$3,500,000) for the 2002-2003 fiscal year. 7 These funds shall be used to reduce the co-payment amount for brand-name prescription 8 drugs for Medicaid recipients from three dollars (\$3.00) to one dollar (\$1.00) per 9 10 prescription.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2002.

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
