A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO GRANT ADDITIONAL FLEXIBILITY WITH REGARD TO THE 3 PURCHASE OF TEXTBOOKS TO THE CHARLOTTE-MECKLENBURG 4 SCHOOLS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding the provisions of Part 3 of Article 8 of 6 Chapter 115C of the General Statutes or any other provision of law, the 7 Charlotte-Mecklenburg Local School Administrative Unit may purchase textbooks on 8 the State-adopted list without using the State textbook distribution system or the 9 10 textbook warehouse facility operated by the State Board of Education. **SECTION 2.** This act applies only to the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Local 11 School Administrative Unit. 12 13

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2002.
