2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE EXPANSION OF THE NORTH
3	CAROLINA AQUARIUM AT PINE KNOLL SHORES.
4	Whereas, in 1998, more than 808,800 people visited the North Carolina
5	Aquariums; and
6	Whereas, in prior enactments of the legislature, the General Assembly has
7	authorized funding for the expansion of the North Carolina Aquariums at Fort Fisher,
8	Roanoke Island, and Pine Knoll Shores; and
9	Whereas, the Fort Fisher and Roanoke Island facilities received funds for
10	expansion; and
11	Whereas, in 1999, funds allocated for capital improvements for the Pine
12	Knoll Shores facility were diverted to the Hurricane Floyd Disaster Relief Fund; and
13	Whereas, the North Carolina Aquarium at Pine Knoll Shores has not had any
14	significant improvements since the facility was constructed in 1974; Now, therefore,
15	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
16	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
17	Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Division of North Carolina
18	Aquariums, the sum of eighteen million three hundred thirteen thousand one hundred

Aquariums, the sum of eighteen million three hundred thirteen thousand one hundred thirty dollars (\$18,313,130) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year for expansion of the North Carolina Aquarium at Pine Knoll Shores.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
