- 2 AN ACT TO FURTHER RESTRICT THE HOUR THAT A TELEPHONE
- 3 SOLICITOR MAY INITIATE A CALL TO A RESIDENTIAL TELEPHONE4 SUBSCRIBER.
- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
 - **SECTION 1.** G.S. 75-30.1(e) reads as rewritten:
- 7 "(e) No telephone solicitor shall initiate a call to a residential telephone subscriber
- 8 after 9:00 P.M.<u>6:00 P.M.</u> or before 8:00 A.M. at the called party's location."
- 9 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2001.
