| 6  | <b>SECTION 1.</b> There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of         |
| 7  | Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two hundred ninety thousand  |
| 8  | dollars (\$290,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year. These funds shall be allocated for |
| 9  | Division TEACCH at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill as follows:        |
| 10 | (1) \$75,000 for a clinical director at the Raleigh TEACCH Center;                    |
| 11 | (2) \$10,500 for consultation to the Murdoch Center for staff training;               |
| 12 | (3) \$90,000 for the UNC Psychiatric Clinic;  |
| 13 | (4) \$115,000 for support staff for the Neuro-Developmental Research                  |
| 14 | Center Autism Research Budget.  |
| 15 | <b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.                            |
