A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT EXEMPTING HOUSING AUTHORITIES FROM THE LOCAL

GOVERNMENT BUDGET AND FISCAL CONTROL ACT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 159-7(b)(10) reads as rewritten:

"(10) 'Public authority' is a municipal corporation (other than a unit of local government) that is not subject to the Executive Budget Act (Article 1 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes) or a local governmental authority, board, commission, council, or agency that (i) is not a municipal corporation, (ii) is not subject to the Executive Budget Act, and (iii) operates on an area, regional, or multi-unit basis, and the budgeting and accounting systems of which are not fully a part of the budgeting and accounting systems of a unit of local government. The term 'public authority' does not mean a housing authority created under Article 1 of Chapter 157 of the General Statutes."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
