1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO GIVE LOCAL FLEXIBILITY REGARDING THE USE OF STATE
3	FUNDS FOR MENTOR TEACHERS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. Funds allocated for mentors shall be used only for teachers and
6	instructional support personnel assigned to newly certified teachers, second-year
7	teachers who were assigned mentors during the prior school year, and entry-level
8	instructional support personnel who have not previously been teachers. These funds
9	shall be used only for:
10	(1) Salary supplements to teachers and instructional support personnel
11	who are serving as mentors. The amount of the salary supplement shall
12	not be based on the number of teachers or instructional support
13	personnel to whom the mentor is assigned; or
14	(2) Payments to teachers or instructional support personnel who are
15	employed solely to serve as mentors. An individual employed solely to
16	serve as a mentor shall receive a payment for each individual to whom
17	the mentor is assigned. The amount of each such payment shall be the
18	same as the amount of the salary supplement for a mentor.
19	SECTION 2. Local boards of education shall report to the State Board of
20	Education on an annual basis on the impact that the mentor program has had on
21	retention of teachers. The State Board shall report on this information to the Joint
22	Legislative Education Oversight Committee.
23	<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
