1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN TRAIL TO
3	REMOVE THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE TOWN ATTORNEY SHALL
4	ATTEND ALL TOWN COUNCIL MEETINGS.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. Section 5.2 of the Charter of the Town of Indian Trail, being
7	Chapter 825 of the 1969 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:
8	"Sec. 5.2. Duties of Town Attorney. It shall be the duty of the Town Attorney to
9	prosecute and defend suits for and against the Town; to advise the Mayor, Town
10	Council, and other Town officials with respect to the affairs of the Town; to draw all
11	legal documents relating to the affairs of the Town; to draw proposed ordinances when
12	requested to do so; to inspect and pass upon all agreements, contracts, franchises and
13	other instruments with which the Town may be concerned; to attend all meetings of the
14	Town Council; and to perform such other duties as may be required of him by virtue of
15	his the position of Town Attorney. The Council shall appoint a Town Attorney licensed
16	to practice law in North Carolina. It shall be the duty of the Town Attorney to represent
17	the Town, advise Town officials, and perform other duties as required by law or as the
18	Council may prescribe."
19	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
