A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENTS OF JUVENILE 3 JUSTICE AND DELINOUENCY PREVENTION AND CORRECTION FOR 4 JUVENILE AND ADULT OFFENDER PROGRAMS IN MECKLENBURG 5 COUNTY.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

There is appropriated from the General Fund to the 7 SECTION 1. 8 Department of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention the sum of one million five hundred eleven thousand dollars (\$1,511,000) for the 2003-2004 fiscal year to be 9 allocated to the Juvenile Crime Prevention Council in Mecklenburg County. These 10 funds shall be used to restore funding for the programs in Mecklenburg County that 11 provide services to at-risk juveniles, juveniles who have been adjudicated delinquent or 12 undisciplined, and the families of those juveniles. 13

14 There is appropriated from the General Fund to the SECTION 2. Department of Correction the sum of four hundred ninety-eight thousand four hundred 15 dollars (\$498,400) for the 2003-2004 fiscal year to be allocated to the Mecklenburg 16 County Criminal Justice Advisory Partnership Board for a grant to the Structured Day 17 Program in Mecklenburg County. The Structured Day Program is an alternative to 18 incarceration providing enhanced supervision, job skill development, and substance 19 abuse treatment to nonviolent drug and property offenders. 20 21

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2003.
