The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SI	ECTION 1. G.S. 136-176 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
"(a2) The Department may use three hundred million dollars (\$300,000,000) in	
fiscal year 2003-2004 and four hundred million dollars (\$400,000,000) in fiscal year	
2004-2005 of the cash balance of the Highway Trust Fund for the following purposes:	
<u>(1</u>	
	existing roadways, signs, signals, and traffic control devices; and
	resurfacing of roadways.
<u>(2</u>	
	implementation of regional public transit systems; modernization of
	rural and urban transit systems operating equipment; improvements to
	rail facilities; improvements to the ferry system; and to assist
	municipalities in incorporating bicycle and pedestrian options into
~	their transportation plans."
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2003.
