A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1

AN ACT REMOVING CERTAIN DESCRIBED PROPERTY FROM THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ROANOKE RAPIDS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The following described property is removed from the corporate limits of the City of Roanoke Rapids:

Being a strip of land 70 (seventy) feet in approximately 656± feet east of the eastern right-of-way line of N.C.S.R. 1710 and approximately 900± feet northeast of the intersection of N.C.S.R. 1734 and N.C.S.R. 1710 in Weldon Township, Halifax County,

- 10 North Carolina, and being more particularly described as follows:
- 11 BEGINNING at an existing iron pipe found, the southeast corner of a 13.892 acre tract
- 12 of land shown on a drawing titled "Plat Showing Property Being Conveyed to Duquesne
- 13 Energy, Inc. from Rightmeyer Machine Rentals, Inc.", recorded at Plat Cabinet 6, Page
- 14 22-T of the Halifax County Registry. Said point of beginning having North Carolina
- Grid (N.A.D. 83) coordinates of N(Y) = 980,659.58 feet and E(X) = 2,405,954.45 feet 15
- 16
- and said point of beginning being further located S 08° 14' 55" W 100.16 feet with and
- 17 along the eastern right-of-way line of N.C.S.R. 1710 and S 89° 42' 48" E - 690.50 feet
- from an existing concrete monument found at the intersection of the northern 18
- right-of-way line of N.C.S.R. 1734 and the eastern right-of-way line of N.C.S.R. 1710; 19
- thence from the point of beginning so located, N 890 42' 48" W 71.32 feet to a point; 20
- thence N 110 20' 22" E 967.45 feet to a point; thence S 89° 47' 37" E 71.34 feet to a 21
- point; thence S 11° 20' 22" W 967.55 feet to the point and place of beginning 22
- 23 containing 67,723 square feet (1.555 acres) plus or minus.
- **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law. 24
