5		SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of the State Building Code or

7		tatutes, a town may require by ordinance the installation of sprinkler systems

10	(a)	Prior to issuance of a certificate of occupancy:
11		(1) Any new occupancy to be established with a rated occupancy load
12		exceeding 200 persons and serving alcohol under a North Carolina
13		ABC classification of private club or retail on-site consumption of
14		mixed drink or malt beverage; or
15		(2) Any new occupancy to be established with a rated occupancy load
16		exceeding 100 persons and serving alcohol under a North Carolina
17		ABC classification of private club or retail on-site consumption of
18		mixed drink or malt beverage and that has any of its required egress
19		points one storey or more above or below grade.
20	(b)	Within five years of the enactment of the requiring ordinance:
21		(1) Any existing occupancy with a rated occupancy load exceeding 200
22		persons and serving alcohol under a North Carolina ABC classification
23		of private club or retail on-site consumption of mixed drink or malt
24		beverage; or
25		(2) Any existing occupancy with a rated occupancy load exceeding 150
26		persons and serving alcohol under a North Carolina ABC classification

3	SECTION 2. This act applies to the Town of Chapel Hill only.
