SENATE BILL 1178 RATIFIED BILL

AN ACT ABOLISHING THE OFFICE OF CORONER IN WILKES COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The office of coroner in Wilkes County is abolished. **SECTION 2.** Chapter 152 of the General Statutes is not applicable to Wilkes County.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective upon the expiration of the term of the current coroner in Wilkes County.
