A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT HUNTING AND FISHING FROM THE RIGHT-OF-WAY 3 IN ROBESON COUNTY. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. It is unlawful to hunt, take, or kill any wild animal or wild 5 bird, or to attempt to hunt, take, or kill any wild animal or wild bird, with the use of a 6 firearm or bow and arrow, from, on, across, or over the roadway or right-of-way of any 7 8 public road, street, or highway. 9 **SECTION 2.** It is unlawful to fish in any body of water from the roadway or right-of-way of any public road, street, or highway. 10 **SECTION 3.** Violation of the provisions of this act is punishable as a Class 11 3 misdemeanor. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 15A-1340.23, violation of this 12 act is punishable by a fine of up to three hundred dollars (\$300.00). A second or 13 14 subsequent violation of Section 1 of this act is punishable by a fine of at least three hundred dollars (\$300.00) and the loss of hunting privileges for a period of 12 months 15 from the date of the violation. 16 SECTION 4. This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the 17 Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by other peace 18 officers with general subject matter jurisdiction. 19 **SECTION 5.** This act applies only to Robeson County. This act becomes 20 effective October 1, 2004, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date. 21
