A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT HUNTING AND FISHING FROM THE RIGHT-OF-WAY IN ROBESON COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** It is unlawful to hunt, take, or kill any wild animal or wild bird, or to attempt to hunt, take, or kill any wild animal or wild bird, with the use of a firearm or bow and arrow, from, on, across, or over the roadway or right-of-way of any public road, street, or highway.

**SECTION 2.** It is unlawful to fish in any body of water from the roadway or right-of-way of any public road, street, or highway.

**SECTION 3.** Violation of the provisions of this act is punishable as a Class 3 misdemeanor. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 15A-1340.23, violation of this act is punishable by a fine of up to three hundred dollars (\$300.00). A second or subsequent violation of Section 1 of this act is punishable by a fine of at least three hundred dollars (\$300.00) and the loss of hunting privileges for a period of 12 months from the date of the violation.

**SECTION 4.** This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by other peace officers with general subject matter jurisdiction.

**SECTION 5.** This act applies only to Robeson County. This act becomes effective October 1, 2004, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
