Short Title: Law Enforcement Use of ATVs. (Local) Sponsors: Representatives Owens; Faison and Ed Jones. Referred to: Local Government I. May 22, 2006 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PERMIT LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS AND FIRST RESPONDERS TO USE ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES ON PUBLIC STREETS AND HIGHWAYS IN CURRITUCK COUNTY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 20-114.2. Law enforcement and first responder all-terrain vehicles permitted on highways. Law enforcement officers enforcing the laws of the State and first responders responding to emergencies may use all-terrain vehicles, as defined in G.S. 14-159.3(b) and owned or leased by the governmental agency, on public streets and highways within North Carolina." **SECTION 2.** This act applies in Currituck County only. **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
