2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE SCIENCE MUSEUMS OF WILSON.
3	Whereas, humans are curious and want to explore their world; and
4	Whereas, the Imagination Station Science Museum serves 28 counties in
5	Eastern North Carolina with hands-on, inquiry-based science education programs to
6	foster the explorer in our students; and
7	Whereas, an interest in science, technology, and computer literacy is vital to
8	the next generation of our workforce; and
9	Whereas, because of Imagination Station Science Museum's efforts, the
10	students of Eastern North Carolina are exposed to unique and thought-provoking
11	science programs that serve as a foundation for these vital skills; and
12	Whereas, Imagination Station Science Museum suffered a tragic fire that
13	consumed the entire live animal collection, destroyed numerous exhibits, and negatively
14	impacted the museum financially; and
15	Whereas, strong community support has raised more than \$1.2 million in
16	capital funds to remodel the prior vacant 1927 Federal Post Office building in
17	downtown Wilson and reopened Imagination Station Science Museum to the citizens of
18	Eastern North Carolina; and
19	Whereas, the museum has a direct economic impact on Wilson County of
20	approximately \$1.5 million dollars annually; Now, therefore,
21	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
22	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Science
23	Museums of Wilson, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of five hundred thousand
24	dollars (\$500,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year to upgrade the technology of the
25	Imagination Station Science Museum's outreach program, renovate the third floor that
26	was destroyed by fire, and develop, renovate, and fabricate exhibits for the main exhibit
27	hall.
28	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
