There is appropriated from the General Fund to the 2 Community Colleges System Office the sum of four million dollars (\$4,000,000) for the 3 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of four million dollars (\$4,000,000) for the 4 2006-2007 fiscal year for the operation of the Customized Industry Training Program, 5 which is established in Section 1 of this act. 6 SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
