A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  AN ACT REMOVING CERTAIN RESTRICTIONS ON SATELLIT ANNEXATIONS FOR THE TOWN OF MAGGIE VALLEY.  The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  SECTION 1. G.S. 160A-58.1(b) reads as rewritten:	ГΕ
"(b) A noncontiguous area proposed for annexation must meet all of the following standards:	ng
(4) If the area proposed for annexation, or any portion thereof, is subdivision as defined in G.S. 160A 376, all of the subdivision mube included.	
(5) The area within the proposed satellite corporate limits, when added the area within all other satellite corporate limits, may not exceed to percent (10%) of the area within the primary corporate limits of the annexing city.  This subdivision does not apply to the Cities of Claremon Concord, Conover, Gastonia, Hickory, Locust, Marion, Mount Air Mount Holly, New Bern, Newton, Oxford, Randleman, Rockingham Sanford, Salisbury, Southport, Statesville, and Washington and the Towns of Angier, Bladenboro, Calabash, Catawba, Creswell, Dalla Fuquay-Varina, Garner, Godwin, Holly Ridge, Holly Springs, Kenl Knightdale, Leland, Louisburg, Maggie Valley, Maiden, Mayoda Midland, Mocksville, Morrisville, Pembroke, Pine Level, Ranl Rolesville, Rutherfordton, Swansboro, Troy, Wallace, Warsar Waynesville, Wendell, and Zebulon."	ten the ont, rry, m, the as, ly, an, lo,
