9	taxable income:
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11	(19) The amount, not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), the parent
12	or grandparent of a designated beneficiary contributed on behalf of the
13	designated beneficiary to the Parental Savings Trust Fund of the State
14	Educational Assistance Authority established pursuant to
15	G.S. 116-209.25. The amount of the deduction may not exceed five
16	thousand dollars (\$5,000) per contributor per beneficiary per taxable
17	year."
18	SECTION 2. G.S. 105-134.6(c) is amended by adding a new subdivision to

20	"(c) Additions. – The following additions to taxable income shall be made in
21	calculating North Carolina taxable income, to the extent each item is not included in

24	(9) The amount deducted from taxable income in a prior taxable year
25	under subdivision (b)(19) of this section to the extent this amount was
26	withdrawn from the Parental Savings Trust Fund of the State
27	Education Assistance Authority established pursuant to
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General Assembly of North CarolinaSession 20051G.S. 116-209.25 and not used to pay for the qualified higher education2expenses of the designated beneficiary, unless the withdrawal was3made without penalty under section 529 of the Code due to the death4or permanent disability of the designated beneficiary."5SECTION 3. This act is effective for taxable years beginning on or after

6 January 1, 2005.
