A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT REMOVING THE CAP ON SATELLITE ANNEXATIONS FOR THE CITY OF GREENVILLE AND THE TOWNS OF SURF CITY AND WINDSOR. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 160A-58.1(b)(5) reads as rewritten: "(b) A noncontiguous area proposed for annexation must meet all of the following standards:		
(5) SECT	The area within the proposed satellite corporate limits, when the area within all other satellite corporate limits, may not of percent (10%) of the area within the primary corporate limin annexing city. This subdivision does not apply to the Cities of Concord, Conover, Gastonia, Greenville, Hickory, Locus Mount Airy, Mount Holly, New Bern, Newton, Oxford, R. Rockingham, Sanford, Salisbury, Southport, Statest Washington and the Towns of Angier, Bladenboro, Catawba, Creswell, Dallas, Fuquay-Varina, Garner, Gody Ridge, Holly Springs, Kenly, Knightdale, Leland, Louisburg Mayodan, Midland, Mocksville, Morrisville, Pembroke, P. Ranlo, Rolesville, Rutherfordton, Surf City, Swansbo Wallace, Warsaw, Waynesville, Wendell, Windsor, and Zebu TION 2.
