<b>SECTION 1.</b> Section 10 of S.L. 2005-144, as amended by S	Section 1 of S.L.
2005-201, reads as rewritten:	
"SECTION 10. Except as otherwise provided, Parts I through VI of	f this act become
effective July 1, 2005, and expire August 5, 2005.at 11:59 P.M. on A	August 11, 2005.
During the period beginning August 12, 2005 and ending January 1, 2	006, no member
of the General Assembly may receive per diem or travel allowance or	n account of the
2005 Regular Session of the General Assembly, except that members	may receive per
diem and travel allowance as provided by law once Senate Bill 622	2, 2005 Regular
Session, is ratified by the General Assembly. Except as otherwis	e provided, the
remainder of this act becomes effective June 30, 2005."	

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
