- 3 SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FOR CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the 6 Department of Public Instruction the sum of six million two hundred twelve thousand 7 four hundred two dollars (\$6,212,402) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to raise the cap on the number of children receiving supplemental funding for children with disabilities. 8 9 Each local school administrative unit shall receive funds for the lesser of (i) all children who are identified as children with disabilities or (ii) twelve and seventy-five one 10 11 hundredths percent (12.75 %) of the 2008-2009 allocated average daily membership in 12 the local school administrative unit. 13

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.

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
