A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE  
3 JUSTICE AND DELINQUENCY PREVENTION FOR THE LOCAL JUVENILE  
4 CRIME PREVENTION COUNCILS THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6       **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the  
7 Department of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention the sum of five million  
8 dollars (\$5,000,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to be allocated to the local Juvenile  
9 Crime Prevention Councils. The funds shall be allocated based on the population of the  
10 counties served by the Councils and shall be used to continue to implement juvenile  
11 justice reform and to provide for early intervention and prevention of juvenile crime and  
12 delinquency. These funds shall be in addition to the amount appropriated in the  
13 continuation budget for local Juvenile Crime Prevention Councils.

14       **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
