2	AN ACT TO AMEND THE SUPPLEMENTAL RETIREMENT FUND FOR
3	VOLUNTEER FIREMEN IN THE TOWN OF ELKIN.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. Subsection (a) of Section 3 of Chapter 391 of the 1971 Session
6	Laws reads as rewritten:
7	"(a) Each active <u>volunteer</u> fireman of the Town who has retired subsequent to
8	January 1, 1969, and who has attained the age of 55 with thirty (30) years' service or
9	more as a town volunteer fireman, shall be entitled to and shall receive in each calendar
10	month following the calendar month in which he or she retires a monthly supplemental
11	retirement benefit equal to one dollar (\$1.00) two dollars (\$2.00) for each full year of
12	service as a volunteer fireman of the Town; provided, in the event, in any calendar
13	month, funds in the Supplemental Retirement Fund are not available to pay a benefit
14	equal to one dollar (\$1.00) two dollars (\$2.00) for each full year of service as a
15	volunteer fireman of the Town, the Board of Trustees shall specify a lesser amount to be
16	paid."
17	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008, and applies to the

18 payment of benefits on or after that date.
