 (a) Any company offering high-speed broadband Internet access to consumer this State shall report annually by January 31 to the Information Systems Division of North Carolina General Assembly on its service areas and its equipment, speed leverand offerings for broadband services within its service areas. The report shall cover preceding calendar year and shall also contain the following information: A description and map of the company's service area clearly indicated where high-speed broadband Internet services are offered within service area, and showing road and street detail with as much added detail as is reasonably necessary to permit identification of the households that have high-speed broadband Internet access and the that do not. Each map shall clearly identify the service area boundary 	the rels, the ting the ress nose nose ries
relative to the county lines and city boundaries within the service a and shall show the names of the counties and cities within the service area. Each map shall indicate the location of the various speeds high-speed broadband Internet service available within the service area. Each map shall be accompanied by any underlying data used the development of the map. - (b) A local government entity, or any subdivision thereof, that offers broadband services or cable television service shall be subject to the reporting requirements of this section, where applicable.
- (c) Proprietary information filed with the Information Systems Division of the North Carolina General Assembly pursuant to this section is confidential, and is not subject to disclosure under Chapter 132 of the General Statutes and may not be released to any person other than to members of the North Carolina General Assembly and its staff, without the express permission of the submitting service provider. Proprietary information is considered a trade secret under the Trade Secrets Protection Act, Article 24 of Chapter 66 of the General Statutes. General information collected by the Information Systems Division of the North Carolina General Assembly may be released or published by the General Assembly without violating this subsection."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
