1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR GANG PREVENTION AND INTERVENTION PROGRAMS IN UNDERSERVED COMMUNITIES ACROSS THE STATE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Governor's Crime Commission the sum of four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to be used as grants for street gang violence prevention and intervention programs. Funds shall be available to local governments and community-based organizations in areas that do not have full-time parks and recreation department staff. The Governor's Crime Commission shall establish the criteria for awarding the grants.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
