 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR GANG PREVENTION AND INTERVENTION PROGRAMS IN UNDERSERVED COMMUNITIES ACROSS THE STATE.

 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Governor's 6 7 Crime Commission the sum of four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) for the 8 2008-2009 fiscal year to be used as grants for street gang violence prevention and intervention programs. Funds shall be available to local governments and 9 community-based organizations in areas that do not have full-time parks and recreation 10 department staff. The Governor's Crime Commission shall establish the criteria for 11 12 awarding the grants. 13 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
