2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR GANG PREVENTION AND
3 INTERVENTION PROGRAMS IN UNDERSERVED COMMUNITIES ACROSS
4 THE STATE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Governor's
7 Crime Commission the sum of four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) for the
8 2008-2009 fiscal year to be used as grants for street gang violence prevention and
9 intervention programs. Funds shall be available to local governments and
10 community-based organizations in areas that do not have full-time parks and recreation
11 department staff. The Governor's Crime Commission shall establish the criteria for
12 awarding the grants.

13 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
