A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REPEAL AN ANNEXATION OF THE TOWN OF NAVASSA.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Annexation Ordinance No. 03-001 of the Town of Navassa, adopted October 9, 2003, is repealed, and the property annexed by that ordinance is removed from the corporate limits of the Town of Navassa.

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect upon the validity of any liens of the Town of Navassa for ad valorem taxes or special assessments outstanding before the effective date of this act. Such liens may be collected or foreclosed upon after the effective date of this act as though the property were still within the corporate limits of the Town of Navassa.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective June 30, 2007.
