A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE CAPE FEAR MUSEUM TO 3 ESTABLISH AN EXHIBIT COMMEMORATING THE 1898 WILMINGTON 4 RACE RIOT, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE 1898 WILMINGTON RACE RIOT 5 COMMISSION.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Cape Fear 7 Museum Associates, Incorporated, a nonprofit organization, the sum of eighty-five 8 9 thousand dollars (\$85,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to establish an exhibit commemorating the 1898 Wilmington Race Riot and to create a companion traveling 10 11 exhibit for use statewide. 12

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
