2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE CAPE FEAR MUSEUM TO
3 ESTABLISH AN EXHIBIT COMMEMORATING THE 1898 WILMINGTON
4 RACE RIOT, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE 1898 WILMINGTON RACE RIOT
5 COMMISSION.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Cape Fear
8 Museum Associates, Incorporated, a nonprofit organization, the sum of eighty-five
9 thousand dollars (\$85,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to establish an exhibit
10 commemorating the 1898 Wilmington Race Riot and to create a companion traveling
11 exhibit for use statewide.

12 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
