A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO EXPAND THE REACH OF NORTH CAROLINA COURTS IN  
2 PROCEEDINGS TO TERMINATE THE PARENTAL RIGHTS OF  
3 NONRESIDENT PARENTS OF RESIDENT CHILDREN.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 7B-1101 reads as rewritten:

7 "**§ 7B-1101. Jurisdiction.**

8 The court shall have exclusive original jurisdiction to hear and determine any  
9 petition or motion relating to termination of parental rights to any juvenile who resides  
10 in, is found in, or is in the legal or actual custody of a county department of social  
11 services or licensed child-placing agency in the district at the time of filing of the  
12 petition or motion. The court shall have jurisdiction to terminate the parental rights of  
13 any parent irrespective of the age of the parent. Provided, that before exercising  
14 jurisdiction under this Article, the court shall find that it has jurisdiction to make a  
15 child-custody determination under the provisions of G.S. 50A-201, 50A-203, or  
16 50A-204. The court shall have jurisdiction to terminate the parental rights of any parent  
17 irrespective of the state of residence of the parent. Provided, that before exercising  
18 jurisdiction under this Article regarding the parental rights of a nonresident parent, the  
19 court shall find that it has jurisdiction to make a child-custody determination under the  
20 provisions of G.S. 50A-201 or G.S. 50A-203, without regard to G.S. 50A-204 and that  
21 process was served on the nonresident parent pursuant to G.S. 7B-1106. Provided,  
22 further, that the clerk of superior court shall have jurisdiction for adoptions under  
23 Chapter 48 of the General Statutes."

24 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to  
25 termination of parental rights proceedings commenced on or after that date.
