A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND
3 HUMAN SERVICES, DIVISION OF AGING AND ADULT SERVICES, FOR
4 PROJECT C.A.R.E. WHICH PROVIDES SUPPORT FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH
5 DEMENTIA AND THEIR CAREGIVERS, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE
6 NORTH CAROLINA STUDY COMMISSION ON AGING.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
9 Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Aging and Adult Services, the
10 sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the
11 sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to fund
12 Project C.A.R.E., which provides support to individuals with dementia and their
13 caregivers.

14 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
