A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE
2 UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF
3 JUSTICE EDUCATION BY SUPPORTING THE LAW SCHOOLS IN THE
4 STATE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
8 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of six million eighty-eight
9 thousand dollars (\$6,088,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of six million
10 eighty-eight thousand dollars (\$6,088,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to improve the
11 quality of justice education by allocating those funds as follows:

- 12 (1) \$3,746,000 shall be allocated each fiscal year to the School of Law at
13 the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill for operating expenses.
14 (2) \$2,342,000 shall be allocated each fiscal year to the School of Law at
15 North Carolina Central University for operating expenses.

16 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
