A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE MULTIUNIT ASSISTED HOUSING WITH SERVICES 3 (MAHS) PROGRAMS TO REGISTER ANNUALLY WITH THE DIVISION OF 4 REGULATION HEALTH SERVICE AND TO **AUTHORIZE** THE 5 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES TO ESTABLISH 6 CERTAIN FEES. AS RECOMMENDED BY THE STUDY COMMISSION ON

AGING.

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The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 131D-2(a)(7a) reads as rewritten:

"(7a) Effective July 1, 1996, "multiunit assisted housing with services" 10 11 means an assisted living residence in which hands-on personal care 12 services and nursing services which are arranged by housing management are provided by a licensed home care or hospice agency, 13 through an individualized written care plan. The housing management 14 has a financial interest or financial affiliation or formal written 15 agreement which makes personal care services accessible and 16 17 available through at least one licensed home care or hospice agency. 18 The resident has a choice of any provider, and the housing management may not combine charges for housing and personal care 19 20 services. All residents, or their compensatory agents, must be capable, through informed consent, of entering into a contract and must not be 21 22 in need of 24-hour supervision. Assistance with self-administration of medications may be provided by appropriately trained staff when 23 delegated by a licensed nurse according to the home care agency's 24 established plan of care. Multiunit assisted housing with services 25 26 programs are required to register register annually with the Division of Health Service Regulation and to provide a disclosure statement. 27

Regulation. The Department shall charge each registered multiunit 1 2 assisted housing with services program a nonrefundable annual 3 registration fee of three hundred and fifty dollars (\$350.00). Any 4 individual or corporation that establishes, conducts, manages, or 5 operates a multiunit housing with services program, subject to 6 registration under this section, that fails to register is guilty of a Class 7 3 misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be punishable only by a fine 8 of not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the first offense and not 9 more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each subsequent offense. 10 Each day of a continuing violation after conviction shall be considered 11 a separate offense. Multiunit assisted housing with services programs 12 are required to provide a disclosure statement to the Division of Health 13 Service Regulation. The disclosure statement is required to be a part of 14 the annual rental contract that includes a description of the following 15 requirements: 16 Emergency response system; a. 17 b. Charges for services offered; 18 Limitations of tenancy; c. Limitations of services; 19 d. 20 Resident responsibilities: e. 21 f. Financial/legal relationship between housing management and 22 home care or hospice agencies; 23 A listing of all home care or hospice agencies and other g. 24 community services in the area; 25 An appeals process; and h. Procedures for required initial and annual resident screening 26 i. 27 and referrals for services. 28 Continuing care retirement communities, subject to regulation by the 29 Department of Insurance under Chapter 58 of the General Statutes, are 30 exempt from the regulatory requirements for multiunit assisted

housing with services programs."

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective January 1, 2010.

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
