2 AN ACT TO CREATE A SALES TAX EXEMPTION FOR PURCHASES OF
3 SCHOOL INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIAL ASSIGNED BY A COURSE
4 INSTRUCTOR AT POSTSECONDARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 105-164.13 is amended by adding a new subdivision to
7 read:

8 "**§ 105-164.13. Retail sales and use tax.**

9 The sale at retail and the use, storage, or consumption in this State of the following
10 tangible personal property and services are specifically exempted from the tax imposed
11 by this Article:

12 ...

13 (14b) Sales of school instructional material to students enrolled at accredited
14 postsecondary educational institutions and assigned by a course
15 instructor."

16 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2008, and applies to
17 sales made on or after that date.
