4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:			
5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial			
6	Department the sum of one hundred seventy thousand three hundred twelve dollars			
7	(\$170,312) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to provide expansion funding for the			
8	Mediation Network of North Carolina. These funds shall be used to increase the funding			
9	at each mediation center by ten percent (10%) to address increases in workload in court		n court	
10 11	referral mediations and to assist with court backlogs.			
11	<b>SECTION 2.</b> There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of one hundred five thousand dollars (\$105,000) for the 2008-2009			
12	fiscal year to establish three new mediation centers for Surry and Stokes Counties,			
13	Rowan County, and Caswell and Person Counties.
