**SENATE BILL 482** Short Title: Use of Emergency Doors/Commission of Larceny. (Public) **Sponsors:** Senator Snow. Referred to: Judiciary ll (Criminal). March 5, 2007 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO INCREASE THE PENALTY FOR LARCENY IF A PERSON USES AN EMERGENCY EXIT DOOR TO LEAVE A RETAIL ESTABLISHMENT WITH STOLEN PROPERTY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 14-72.1 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: "(d2) Notwithstanding subsection (e) of this section, any person who violates subsection (a) of this section by exiting a retail establishment through an emergency door is guilty of a Class H felony if the exit door is installed and maintained to comply with Federal Occupational Health and Safety Administration rules requiring retailers to provide emergency exit doors that must remain unlocked." **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2007, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
