5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-183.7(a) reads as rewritten:
7	"§ 20-183.7. Fees for performing an inspection and putting an inspection sticker
8	on a vehicle; use of civil penalties.
9	(a) (Effective until July 1, 2007) Fee Amount. – When a fee applies to an
10	inspection of a vehicle or the issuance of an inspection sticker, the fee must be
11	collected. The following fees apply to an inspection of a vehicle and the issuance of an
12	inspection sticker:

14	<u>Type</u> <u>Inspection</u> <u>Sticker</u>
15	Safety Only \$ 8.25 \$0.85
16	Emissions and Safety23.506.50.

18	The fee for performing an inspection of a vehicle applies when an inspection is
19	performed, regardless of whether the vehicle passes the inspection. The fee for an
20	inspection sticker applies when an inspection sticker is put on a vehicle. The fee for
21	inspecting after-factory tinted windows shall be ten dollars (\$10.00), and the fee applies
22	only to an inspection performed with a light meter after a safety inspection mechanic
23	determined that the window had after-factory tint. A safety inspection mechanic shall
24	not inspect an after-factory tinted window of a vehicle for which the Division has issued
25	a medical exception permit pursuant to G.S. 20-127(f).

1 A vehicle that is inspected at an inspection station and fails the inspection is entitled 2 to be reinspected at the same station at any time within <u>3060</u> days of the failed 3 inspection without paying another inspection fee.

The inspection fee for an emissions and safety inspection set out in this subsection is the maximum amount that an inspection station or an inspection mechanic may charge for an emissions and safety inspection of a vehicle. An inspection station or an inspection mechanic may charge the maximum amount or any lesser amount for an emissions and safety inspection of a vehicle. The inspection fee for a safety only inspection set out in this subsection may not be increased or decreased. The sticker fees set out in this subsection may not be increased or decreased.

(a) (Effective July 1, 2007) Fee Amount. – When a fee applies to an inspection
of a vehicle or the issuance of an inspection sticker, the fee must be collected. The
following fees apply to an inspection of a vehicle and the issuance of an inspection
sticker:

20 The fee for performing an inspection of a vehicle applies when an inspection is 21 performed, regardless of whether the vehicle passes the inspection. The fee for an 22 inspection sticker applies when an inspection sticker is put on a vehicle. The fee for an 23 inspection sticker does not apply to a replacement inspection sticker for use on a 24 windshield replaced by a business registered with the Division pursuant to 25 G.S. 20-183.6. The fee for inspecting after-factory tinted windows shall be ten dollars 26 (\$10.00), and the fee applies only to an inspection performed with a light meter after a 27 safety inspection mechanic determined that the window had after-factory tint. A safety 28 inspection mechanic shall not inspect an after-factory tinted window of a vehicle for 29 which the Division has issued a medical exception permit pursuant to G.S. 20-127(f).

30 A vehicle that is inspected at an inspection station and fails the inspection is entitled 31 to be reinspected at the same station at any time within 3060 days of the failed 32 inspection without paying another inspection fee.

The inspection fee for an emissions and safety inspection set out in this subsection is the maximum amount that an inspection station or an inspection mechanic may charge for an emissions and safety inspection of a vehicle.
