5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-175(d) reads as rewritten:
7	"(d) Local governments may enact ordinances restricting or prohibiting a person
8	from standing on any street, highway, or right-of-way excluding sidewalks while
9	soliciting, or attempting to solicit, any employment, business, or contributions from the
10	driver or occupants of any vehicle. No local government may enact or enforce any
11	ordinance that prohibits the news media from engaging in the distribution of newspapers
12	on the non-traveled portion of any street or highway except when the distribution
13	activities of the media industry impede the normal movement of traffic on the street or
14	highway. This subsection does not permit additional restrictions or prohibitions on the
15	activities of licensees, employees, or contractors of the Department of Transportation or
16	of any municipality engaged in construction or maintenance or in making traffic or
17	engineering surveys except as provided in subsection (e) of this section."
18	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
