A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE CONTINUATION OF A PROVEN 3 CAMPAIGN RELATED COMMUNITY EDUCATION TO STROKE. AS 4 RECOMMENDED BY THE JUSTUS-WARREN HEART DISEASE AND STROKE 5 PREVENTION TASK FORCE. 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 7 Health and Human Services, Division of Health Services, the sum of four hundred fifty 8 thousand dollars (\$450,000) for the 2010-2011 fiscal year. These funds shall be used for the 9 continuation of a proven community education campaign regarding the signs and symptoms of 10 stroke and the need for immediate action, and for the Stroke Advisory Council to further the 11 development of a comprehensive plan for the prevention of stroke and the proper care of stroke 12 13 patients. 14 SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2010.
