Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 40A-1, in the exercise of its eminent domain for the acquisition of property interests (including, without be simple title, rights-of-way, and easements) to be used for waterlines and ilities, and sewer lines and treatment facilities, and opening, widening, extending, public streets and roads, a town may use the authority and procedure prescribed in Chapter 136 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, as now or hereafter wided further, that whenever the words 'Secretary' or 'Secretary of Transportation' shall be deemed to be 'Town Manager,' and whenever the word 'highway' appears, to include 'public works' in accordance with this section, providing further that n shall be construed to enlarge the power of the town to condemn property already public use; provided further, just compensation for the acquisition of fee simple betual easement pursuant to this section to be used for street or road right-of-way ess than (i) one dollar (\$1.00) per square foot of real property taken or (ii) the alorem tax value of the parent tract, whichever is less.
